- Title: 24 pt, Bold, Center aligned
- Heading Level 1: 12 pt Bold
- Heading Level 2: 10 pt Bold
- Heading Level 3: 10 pt Italic
- Abstract: 150–250 words, no references
- Keywords: 3–7 keywords separated by commas
- Figures: Center Aligned and Caption below figure (8 pt)  
Example: Figure 3. Workflow of the Proposed Methodology.  
Inside paragraph:  
The proposed methodology is illustrated in **Figure 1**.
- Figures must be clear, properly labeled, and of high resolution (minimum 300 dpi).
- Tables: Center Aligned and Caption above table (8 pt)  
Example: Table 1. Performance Comparison of Algorithms  
Correct usage inside paragraph:  
Table 2 shows the performance comparison....
- Add neat, properly aligned, and well-formatted tables.
- ✓ Number the figures sequentially (Figure 1, Figure 2...)
- ✓ Number the tables separately (Table 1, Table 2...)
- ✓ Do not mix numbering of figures and tables
- ✓ Each figure/table must be referenced in text/paragraph
- ✓ High resolution images (300 dpi minimum)
- References: IEEE citation style, 8 pt, hanging indent
  - ✓ References numbered in order of appearance
  - ✓ Use square brackets: [1], [2], [3]
  - ✓ Numbering is sequential
  - ✓ Use Times New Roman, 8 pt
  - ✓ Single spacing
  - ✓ Hanging indent (0.5 cm recommended)
